1. MINUTES

3. APPLICATIONS FOR THE GRANT, RENEWAL, SUSPENSION OR REVOCATION OF HACKNEY CARRIAGE AND PRIVATE HIRE VEHICLE DRIVER LICENCES AND APPEALS AGAINST ALLOCATION OF PENALTY POINTS ON PRIVATE HIRE VEHICLE DRIVER'S LICENCES

The Director of Environment and Neighbourhood Services submitted a report asking the Sub-Committee to consider an application for the grant of a three year private hire vehicle driver's licence.

A summary of the circumstances of the case was appended to the report.

Resolved -

That the application by MI for the grant of a three year private hire vehicle driver's licence be refused due to him not being considered a fit and proper person by reason of:

- (a) the nature of the offences, as detailed in the report;

- (c) his failure to attend the Sub-Committee meeting and provide reasons for his non-attendance.
