### 11. APPLICATION FOR THE GRANT OF A PRIVATE HIRE (SCHOOL TRANSPORT) VEHICLE OPERATOR'S LICENCE - MS SCHOOL TRANSPORT & WHEELCHAIR, PROSPECT MEWS, READING

The Director of Environment and Neighbourhood Services submitted a report on an application by EA for the grant of a private hire (school transport) vehicle operator's licence in respect of MS School Transport & Wheelchair, 3A Prospect Mews, Reading, RG1 7YJ.

**Resolved -**
