Why is reading so important?

- of children left primary school last year unable to read to the required level.
 - of those in Young Offenders' institutions have **literacy levels below** that expected of a 7 year old.
- of pupils permanently excluded from school have difficulties with basic literacy.

Failure to read can lead to poor behaviour, truancy, poor job prospects and possibly crime.
