Cow Lane

I am sure cycle users and pedestrians would be keen to learn when will the unequal pedestrian footpaths between the two railway bridges in Cow Lane be remodelled, to provide for a safer wider pavement than currently exists between these two bridges?

<u>REPLY</u> by Councillor Page:

As detailed in the Major Projects Update report to this meeting of the Sub-Committee, Network Rail have informed the Council that they hope to commence construction of the Cow Lane highway improvements in October this year. They expect the works to take 6 months to complete. The Council will continue to work alongside Network Rail on this project, in particular to ensure disruption to residents and businesses is kept to a minimum during the construction process.
