7. APPLICATIONS FOR THE GRANT, RENEWAL, SUSPENSION OR REVOCATION OF HACKNEY CARRIAGE AND PRIVATE HIRE VEHICLE DRIVER LICENCES AND APPEALS AGAINST ALLOCATION OF PENALTY POINTS ON PRIVATE HIRE VEHICLE DRIVER'S LICENCE

The Director of Environment and Neighbourhood Services submitted a report asking the Sub-Committee to consider the suspension or revocation of private hire and hackney carriage vehicle driver's licences.

A summary of the circumstances of the case was appended to the report.

Resolved -

- (1) That having considered the oral and written representations and the Council's Taxi and PHV Licensing Criminal Convictions' Policy, on the balance of probabilities, the private hire vehicle driver's licence and hackney carriage vehicle driver's licence in respect of NY remain in force;
- (2) That NY must be stringent in his behaviour and must not put himself in any situation that could be open to misinterpretation.
