This figure comprises £6.6m in RBC capital supplemented by an assumed income from grants of £420k. A recent grant application to the Public Sector Decarbonisation Scheme for the Hexagon Theatre was unsuccessful but the Council will continue to pursue external funds.
- 2. This is not an exhaustive list of projects which will contribute to the Council's net zero objectives a range of transport, waste, housing, school and other investments will do likewise, but are not included in this programme.
