Dear Licensing Department

We are writing to show our support for Sangita Gurung the landlady of the Red Cow in Caversham and are shocked and dismayed that the pub may have to close. During Sangita's time as landlady she has transformed the pub into a friendly welcoming place to meet with friends and take family. The pub has become an important part of the local community, Sangita has held charity nights to help raise money for local people who may be experiencing difficult times either through illness or hardship.

Sangita has notices up in the pub to remind customers that she will not tolerate loud disorderly behaviour and anyone seen to be using drugs, or trying to sell stolen goods will be removed from the pub and the police will be called.

Children are welcome in the pub with their families and children need to leave by 9am, Sangita asks for identification following the standard guidelines to prevent underage drinking .

The doors into the garden are kept closed after 9 and customers asked to respect the local neighbours by keeping the noise to a minimum.

The pub was closed for a long time before Sangita took it over and is the only local pub in the surrounding area and this provides a friendly and social environment for all and offers somewhere for anyone that might live alone to come in for a drink, chat and have a hot meal who may not have the opportunity or money to travel into Reading.
