As most Taxis are diesel shouldn't they all now conform to Euro 6 emissions standards or better which date to vehicles manufactured from 2016 (and therefore 5+ years at addition to taxi fleet). Hybrid petrol are probably preferable to diesel or hybrid diesel vehicles if not full BEV's. Can council not insist that all Taxis are BEV's like Mayor Kahn's policy in London?

I disagree with this proposal as doesn't consider any financial benefit to drivers. If it's all about the environmental impact then vehicle owners should be helped by council as much as Reading Buses.
