## 4. Decision details:

Delegation agreed at Council (October 2024) related to the 'TRO Rectification report' ([here](#)) as follows:

*'Authorise the Assistant Director of Environment and Commercial Services in consultation with the Assistant Director of Legal and Democratic Services to undertake a statutory consultation for the proposals contained within paragraph 3.9 and Appendix 1 in accordance with the Local Authorities Traffic Orders (Procedure) (England and Wales) Regulations 1996 and subject to there being no objections received following the statutory consultation, to arrange for the order to be made and sealed so the restrictions can be implemented.'*

TRO1 (Red Route East)

The statutory consultation has been undertaken and ended 5 January 2025. A sufficient period has now been allowed for receipt of postal representation – none has been received.

There was a single submission of support during the statutory consultation and no objections. Therefore, under the delegation above, officers will proceed to sealing/making this Traffic Regulation Order.

## 5. Reasons for the decision:

No objections were received in respect of this consulted [draft] Traffic Regulation Order, therefore the decision has been taken to seal the Order so that the restrictions may be brought into force.
