5. Reasons for the decision:

Funding for Local Authority New Build schemes is made up of a combination of HRA borrowing, RTB receipts, S106 receipts and Homes England grant.

On 20th January 2025, Policy Committee approved permission to bid for Homes England grant funding for all appropriate schemes within the LANB programme, with final approvals of the details of the bids delegated to the Executive Director of Communities and Adult Social Care, in consultation with the Director of Finance and the Lead Councillor for Housing.

On 12th February 2025, MHCLG announced top up funding for the Affordable Homes Programme 2021-2026 and recommended that bids for Hexham Road, Amethyst Lane and Dwyer Road were submitted.

On 24th March 2025, Homes England confirmed a final award as follows:
