1. Title of decision:	To enter a works contract with Woodlands Corporate Interiors Ltd to refurbish 59 Honey End Lane for RBC Children's Homes

- a) To seek approval to appoint Woodlands Corporate Interiors Ltd to carry out refurbishment works to 59 Honey End Lane for the use of a Children's Home.
- b) To provide an update on the now concluded compliant procurement and evaluation process.

5. Reasons for the decision:

- a) Procurement under the 2015 Public Contract Regulations has been concluded.
- b) Quality (Technical) and Price (Commercial) evaluation have been concluded and moderated by the procurement team.
- c) The market has offered costs that are within our existing budget, and a programme that suggests completion by the end of this financial year, ready for Children's Services to use this from the start of the new financial year.
- d) We have procured this through the Westworks DPS to give us confidence that all contractors have the skills and experience to carry out the works required.
- e) This decision is required to enable us to inform the contractors of our intentions to appoint them as soon as internal governance approvals are concluded.

- The option to continue housing children out of borough was rejected.
- Tenders were received from 8 bidders.
- All submissions were considered and clarifications sought and reviewed.
- One contractor withdrew their submission, and one other was found to be non-compliant.
