


APPENDIX 1 - TRO RECTIFICATION FOR EAST STREET PAY AND DISPLAY

Summary of feedback received to the proposed Traffic Regulation Order

Objection/Support/Neither support nor object	Comments
1. Objection	<p>I am writing to object to the proposal as currently set out, and to request a modification to the operating days of the pay and display restriction on East Street (east side, near South Street). While I understand the council's intention to regularise the Traffic Regulation Order and recommence enforcement, I do not consider it proportionate for this bay to operate on a Monday to Sunday basis. Extending pay and display to weekends, particularly Sundays, places unnecessary restriction on short-stay parking when traffic demand and commercial activity are materially lower. Since enforcement has lapsed, this consultation presents an opportunity not just to rectify the legal position but to reassess how the space is used. A Monday to Friday restriction would continue to support weekday traffic management while providing greater flexibility for residents, visitors, and local activity at weekends. I would therefore ask the council to amend the proposal so that pay and display operates Monday to Friday only, rather than seven days a week, before making the order. For these reasons, I object to the order being made in its current form.</p>
